Dear Members:







# Ibizan Hund Club of the United States National Specialty

September 16, 2016

Judge's Comments by Russell L. McFadden



So here it is 23 ½ years later and I once again had the pleasure of judging the Ibizan Hound National Specialty. Many judges never get to judge any breed's national specialty in their entire judging careers so to be asked back a second time is truly a supreme honor. My thanks to the members of the club for entrusting me with this assignment. I enjoy judging all of the breeds in the Hound Group (and IGs) but I especially love judging one of my favorite breeds and Ibizan Hounds are easily one of my favorites. I thoroughly enjoy it each time I get to step in into the center of the ring I hope that the exhibitors are having as much fun as I am.

So, as I said in my critique so many years ago, I passionately believe that in order to judge any breed that one has to have a vast understanding of not only the breed's written standard but also of the basic purpose of the breed. Knowledge of the standard gives one the insight to look for the parts of the dog and how they should smoothly fit together; understanding the history of the breed gives one the ability to apply the standard to the function for which that breed was established. Ibizan Hounds, as we all know, are structurally unique in many ways because of the terrain over which the breed was used for hunting. They are also unique in personality and intelligence which makes them such wonderful companions.

In general, I felt this was this was a really caliber entry. I saw lots of quality in both the youngest dogs all the way through to the oldest ones there. I congratulate the breeders who have worked diligently to improve the breed to its current level of correctness. The one big thing I think breeders still need to watch out for are correct fronts that give the Ibizan the slight lift at the pastern I think one should see from the side when the dog moves. An Ibizan Hound shouldn't move like a Doberman Pinscher and in years past there seemed to be a lot of that type of front movement. I did see this movement in a few of the exhibits in Missouri.

In particular, what I want to see in any exhibit is, of course, perfection. I look for a correct deer-like elegance in outline with large correct ears, a long neck set into smooth well laid back shoulders, a proper almost level topline with a slight arch over the loin, etc. I can continue quoting the standard here but I think I've gotten the idea across that what I am looking for is how well each exhibit fits my understanding of the standard. So with this in mind the higher an exhibit placed in a class where there was competition the more I felt that exhibit fell into my definition of my ideal. And in the single entry classes if I hadn't felt the entry wasn't worthy of a first place ribbon I would not have awarded one.

The **4-6 month puppy class** was a joy to see. This class is the future of the breed and it was a lovely class. Unfortunately, as with any puppy class the age of the entry can make a big difference and the very, very nice younger wire puppies were at a disadvantage coming up against the smooth puppies who were two months older. That two month difference in a larger breed makes a huge difference in movement and structural development. My Best of Breed was a very pretty bitch that was a standout from the time she entered the ring. She was very nice in every way with a pretty outline, nice balanced side movement and clean on the down and back. I will be interested to follow her actual show career because she should easily finish if she continues to grow into herself.

Best of Opposite went to her litter brother who again was a standout. He was very close to his sister in every aspect but that day I just felt she was just a bit the better of the two.

**Reserve Winners Dog:** First place in the Bred-By Dog Class. This dog, Redfaire's First Adventure, is a very nice male with a nice outline, nice head and expression and nice correct ears. He has very clean easy movement both down and back and from the side. He has a good, proper wire coat. He needs just a touch more front fill but nothing significant.

**Winners Dog:** From the Open Class. This dog, IcyCold Infinity 2the3rd Power, is a stellar example of the breed that will easily finish his championship if he hasn't already done so since the National. He has a beautiful head and expression, correct ears and ear set, and a beautiful neck set into correct shoulders. He has a correct straight upper arm, nice moderate rear angulation and a balanced, correct outline. He moves with ease both coming and going and from the side. It was easy to give him Winners Dog because he was a standout in a lineup of very nice dogs in the Winners Class.

**Reserve Winners Bitch:** First place in the 9-12 Puppy Bitch Class. This young bitch, Afilador Could It Be Magic, is a very pretty puppy. I went back and forth between her and the winner of the 6-9 Puppy Bitch Class for my Reserve placement and finally this bitch being a little more mature and together won out. She is one to watch because I think she could be a big winner if she continues to mature proportionately. She has a very correct outline and lovely easy movement. I was very impressed with this young lady.

**Winners Bitch:** From the Bred-By Class. This lovely bitch, IcyCold Third Time, has it all going for her. She is as lovely to look at as she is a joy to watch move. She has a beautiful outline, beautiful head and expression, correct ears, beautiful neck set into correct shoulders. She is moderate in angulation and has light easy, clean movement both coming and going and from the side. She is one that I would be proud to say that I bred or owned if she were mine. She was ultimately Best of Winners.

**Best of Winners:** As stated above was Winners Bitch. This placement could have easily gone either way because I liked both Winners Dog and Winners Bitch tremendously. Winners bitch, however, had just a little more elegance (as the bitches more often than not do) and was a little lighter on her feet so she ended up with this placement.

The **Specials Class** was truly a sight to behold. There were many that I wish that I could have acknowledged that I wasn't able to because there were only so many ribbons that could be handed out. So out of this large entry the final set of ribbons went to dogs and bitches that I felt most correctly exemplified the breed at this show. I want to say that I would be happy to award a Best of Breed ribbon to any of these dogs on any other occasion.

**AOMs:** The Awards of Merit went to GCh. Gryphons Nick of Time from the 7-9 Veteran Dog Class, DC Harehill's Slots-A-Fun MC LCX from the fro the 7-9 Veteran Bitch Class, and GCh. Harehill's More Than Scandalous. The two younger veterans had all of the attributes I was looking for – nice outlines and correct easy movement. The male has a correct wire coat. The winner of the third AOM although not quite as good in the movement department as some of the other dogs and bitches there, makes an absolutely stunning picture standing. She exudes breed style and I felt I had to recognize her for this reason.

**Select Dog:** Ch. Harehill's Crazy Little Thing Called Love – this is a nice masculine dog that is very correct in every way. He has a nice head with good expression and good ears. His neck flows smoothly into nicely laid back shoulders and proper straight upper arm. He has a nice, correct, outline with moderate angulation. He has and easy clean movement both coming and going and from the side.

**Select Bitch:** GCh. Harehill's Agent Provocateur SC – this is a lovely feminine bitch that is also correct in every way. She has a pretty head with good expression, nicely set, correct ears. She has a lovely neck set into nicely laid back shoulders. She has a correct upper arm, nice topline and moderate rear angulation. She has nice easy movement both coming and going and from the side. Both the Select Dog and Select Bitch were serious contenders for the Best of Breed ribbon.

**Best of Opposite Sex:** GCh. DC Kamar Alisian Fields Li Lava Dear SC – this is a stunning bitch no matter which way one looks at her. She has tons of style and is totally sound. Starting from the tip her nose to the tip of her tail she is what I think an Ibizan Hound bitch should be. She has a lovely head, has great expression and nice large properly set ears. She has a lovely neck that flows into smooth nicely laid back shoulders and nice strong topline and moderately angulated rear. She has a nice front with a straight upper arm and good front fill. Her movement is light and easy both coming and going and from the side. It came down to a close decision between this bitch and the dog to which I ultimately gave the Best of Breed ribbon.

**Best of Breed:** GChS Sunrumba's Lovestruck By Life: What more can I say about this dog that this placement doesn't already say? In a beautiful class, in a beautiful entry, this is the dog that I believe best epitomized the breed on this day. When I close my eyes to try to imagine a picture that fits my understanding of the standard it is this type this of dog that I see. He has "deer-like elegance" but is masculine without being overdone in any way. He has a beautiful head, wonderful expression, and properly set correct ears. His neck flows smoothly into beautifully laid back shoulders. He has a correct topline, correct upper arm, and has a correct outline with moderate angulation. His movement from the side and coming and going is light and easy and effortless.
