

IHCUS LURE COURSING COMMITTEE

Guidelines and Procedures

The IHCUS Lure Coursing Committee's purpose is to promote and educate the IHCUS members and the Ibizan fancy about the coursing tradition and venues available for our Breed. Preserving this portion of the Hunting Heritage is an important factor in preserving type.

COURSING COMMITTEE CHAIR

The Chair shall be a volunteer position approved by the Board of Directors. The individual shall be required by the Board to have lure coursing experience in both AKC and ASFA venues, and be familiar, or be willing to become familiar with NOTRA, NOFCA and LGRA venues. Having been a Lure Coursing Trial Secretary or Chairperson, for a AKC and/or ASFA trials, would be helpful.

The Committee Chair shall also serve as the IHCUS delegate for ASFA (American Sighthound Field Association). As ASFA sends out notices to the delegates, this individual will pass pertinent information to the IHCUS members through official channels of communication to include email and Third Eye quarterly publications.

In addition, the Chair shall be the liaison to notify the Board of Directors of rule changes which will impact any coursing event IHCUS would host (i.e. AKC or ASFA field trials, Coursing Ability Tests)

The Chair will also assist any IHCUS Member or Affiliated Club that wishes to host an IHCUS LC event or supported entry, if requested to do so by the Member or Club. This may include but is not limited to Judge's selection, course design and premium editing, ribbon/rosette purchases.

The Committee Chair will keep track and publish the ASFA and AKC Top Ten FINAL yearly standings in the Third Eye. They will also provide this information to the Awards Committee Chair on a timely basis.
