
GUIDELINES FOR SUBMITTING CONTENT TO THE THIRD EYE

The intention of these guidelines is to make sure content is submitted legally, is appropriate for this publication, and meets the specifications required for print. Most of this shouldn't be new to members who have previously sent things in. These guidelines have been approved by the BOD.

Please contact us if you have any questions!

-ADVERTISEMENTS-

- Completed full page ads should be 8.5" x 11.25" with full bleed.
- Photos submitted for a club-made ad should be as large as possible and 300dpi. Small images will not print well.
- Any photos that are not official win photos or taken by the dog's owner/ breeder must include the name of the photographer, along with a statement that the owner has permission to use the photograph(s).
- Ads for stud dogs or litters are strongly encouraged to include the parents' OFA numbers and if any health testing has been done. Please remember that the IHCUS COE requires breeding dogs be checked for hereditary defects.
- Any mention of ranking must include the most recently posted AKC/Chronicle/Dog News rankings and state the month and which system is being used. If a past year's ranking is being mentioned, the year and which system should still be included, and it should be the ranking from the end of that year.
- Ad placement is first come, first serve. Ads for premium placement - inside front cover, inside back cover, and back cover - must be paid for and received by that issue's deadline. No exceptions. Premium placement ads not received by the deadline will be downgraded to a regular ad and the premium page will be offered to whoever can immediately fill it. All other ads will be placed as needed, based on where color pages fit within that issue. We will try to meet your desires for near the front, etc. but we cannot guarantee placement beyond the premium pages.
- Accepted file types for completed ads or images are PDF, JPG, PNG, or Adobe Photoshop. Please feel free to ask if you need help with this.



-ARTICLES-

- We welcome reprints! Please provide info on where the article is originally from (such as magazine name and issue number), along with correspondence obtaining permission for the Third Eye to print the article and how it should be credited.
- All health-related articles must include sources and/or citations for claims, **no exceptions**. These must be legitimate sources, such as research studies done by respected organizations or articles written by people with degrees from accredited schools in a related subject.
- All non-ad mentions of dogs' registered names, such as specialty results or Top 10, will be printed as provided by the show superintendent or the AKC, whichever is applicable. This also applies to the dog's owners and/or breeders.
- Please make sure the text of the article is print-ready. It should be proofed, have long links removed, etc. Word or Doc files are preferred, or the text placed in an e-mail, but PDF is also acceptable.
- Specialty and supported entry results will be printed as reported by the superintendent.
- **Anyone submitting an original article, minimum 2 pages, that is well-written and relevant to our breed will receive a 25% discount on an ad of their choice.**

-BRAGS, ETC.-

- New Title brags can now choose to pay \$15 to "upgrade" their brag. This will include a black and white 1/4 page with the dog's photo, regularly included information (registered and call names, owner and breeder), and one extra line of text. What the extra line says is up to you! Mention where the title was earned, congratulate the breeder, tell readers that it's the 4th dog from the litter to earn a title, whatever you'd like.
- Receive a group placement recently? Have a small copy of the win photo included in an issue at no charge! Color or black and white is at the editor's digression, based on where space is available.

-COVERS-

- All cover submissions must be of dogs no longer being shown in conformation (or who were never shown to begin with), with the exception of unidentifiable puppies.
- Photos must be large, of good quality, and generally fit the shape of the cover.
- Photos must be your own. Photos taken by others will only be accepted if the submitter is the owner of the dog and includes proof that permission has been obtained specifically for the cover – a screenshot of a facebook conversation, forwarding of an e-mail, etc. Proof of permission is also needed if the submitter is the photographer but not the owner of the dog.

Called meeting to order 8:06 PM EST

PRESIDENT REPORT: No report.

SECRETARY REPORT: M. Pierotti-Tietje moves to accept the February meeting minutes as posted. E. Seward seconds the motion. Vote: All in favor, motion passed.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

- Breeder Referral: Nine breeder referral inquiries for March. C. Allen moves to accept changes to the Breeder Referral program which will eliminate the fee to be listed and remove individual litter or dogs available listings. E. Seward seconds the motion. Each board member discussed their thoughts about the revised program. Majority agreed to leave breeder's contact number and state as an optional listing. Document will be revised with discussed changes and presented in April.

- Judges Education: E. Liebes has changed some photos in the Illustrated Standard and wants the Board to look it over and approve.
- Lure Coursing: Nothing to report.
- Membership applications: C. Allen made a motion, D. Nester seconded to make Lisa Venegas a member. All in favor, no opposition, no abstained. Notify Lisa that she's been approved. Final tally for 2018 member

103 in good standing. Discussion was held to send out membership apps in real time for members to approve.

- National Specialty: Nothing to report.
- Newsletter - Third Eye: C. Allen proposed at the last meeting that the board should consider not sending minutes out to non-members. M. Pierotti-Tietje proposed that the editor cut out the minutes to the non-members by hand as it would cost too much to do a small run. C. Allen made a motion that we put the minutes in the center of the TE then physically remove each of them from the TE by hand from any of the non-member issues. S. Tinch seconded. No discussion, all approved, no opposition, no abstain. C. Allen made a motion that we move the non-member subscribers to a digital only copy of the TE at a greatly reduced rate determined by Board at renewal. Erica seconded. 4 voted yes, 1 voted no, 1 abstained.

- Outreach: 3 notes sent.
- Rescue: Report is on the forum in correspondence. Respond whether or not board members are okay with the report.
- Ways and Means: Nothing to report.
- Website: C. Allen said there are a couple links on AKC website that were not working. She sent the current information to them. Third Eye archives are still in progress. C. Allen would like to send out an email asking for website updates. Third Eye is sent via email as USPS is sometimes slow, C. Allen would like to send it out so that we are able to meet deadlines for voting, etc.. S. Tinch made a motion that we send a digital copy of the Third Eye to all members, A. Mitchell-Lynch seconded. All in favor, no opposed, abstain. Motion passed.

C. Shaw will start working on AKC parent club flyer program that hopefully will be ready by the first of April.

NEW BUSINESS

New membership application process proposal. A. Mirestes sent in a proposal to make changes to the way the membership process is done. The

applicant's name will be emailed to membership with 20 days to comment, the listing will still be in the Third Eye. It makes the process shorter. This would be a by-law change and would have to be put to the membership for a vote before it could be sent to AKC. C. Shaw will send it to AKC for approval prior to putting it to the membership. C. Allen made a motion that we will present AKC approved membership changes to the membership to amend our bylaws so that the membership applications shall be sent to them as received. D. Nester seconded. All in favor, no opposed, no abstain.

Mirestes presented would like to propose as an incentive and reinforcer for completing CHIC, IHCUS pay the OFA application fee for litters out of CHIC registered sires and dams belonging to IHCUS members. required to maintain the database currently. Her computer is a Chrome notebook. C. Shaw asked if E. Seward could reach out to Erica Kasper and see what she was using to run the program and maybe IHCUS could find a used laptop that could work for her.

Parent Club flyer program: C. Shaw said that we are going to leave the picture as is and go ahead and send the flyer out to AKC for their use. D. Nester moved to use the current flyer, M. Pierotti-Tietje seconded, all in favor, no opposed, no abstain. Motion passed.

M. Pierotti-Tietje is concerned that the newsletter will be shared and forwarded to non-members if we send out digital copies, so she feels that there should be repercussions where someone is sharing club business and asked that there be a disclaimer stating that this is a paid for subscription and not to be forwarded and/or reproduced. C. Allen said she could do that.

Any changes in the current bylaws, changing the membership process is ok with AKC. Proposed changes would be for the president to serve on the board as advisory only, no voting. Possibly changing a director position to a recording secretary to record the things that have to do with recording club business, executive meetings, reporting to AKC, etc., corresponding


would be responsible for anything having to do with notifications, etc.. C. Shaw feels that we are growing enough that we would need another person to handle the load of the secretary.

NEW BUSINESS

Brenda Murray asked if IHCUS could offer a challenge trophy for best Junior handler, they would have to win it 3 times in a row in order to keep it. doesn't need to have the same dog. D. Nestor made a motion that we approve the request to offer a challenge trophy in honor of Tonka, S. Tinch seconded. No questions, no comments, all in favor, no opposed, no abstained.

Changes in the versatility program: C. Allen and T. Bausch went through and added some of the new AKC certifications. C. Shaw thinks we should offer points for a national owner handled BIS. No formal registry service for service dogs, we may need to think on how we are wording it. C. Allen made a motion that we eliminate points for service dogs, as there is no formal registry for service dogs currently and add OH BIS to the wild card category. M. Pierotti-Tietje seconded. All in favor, no opposed, no abstained.

Meeting was adjourned at 9:00 EST.

IHCUS is not responsible for addressing any e-mail communications that use a Board member's personal e-mail address. *Please use the IHCUS designated e-mail addresses such as secretary@ihcus.org etc., which are listed in every newsletter and are on the IHCUS website.*

Response Time Goals: The Secretary will acknowledge receipt of communications no later than 7 working days from receipt date. The Board strives to provide a response *no later than 10 working days after the next scheduled IHCUS Board meeting.*



IHCUS Versatility Certificate Award Program

All IHCUS Sponsored awards can be used as a "Suffix" on all personally created pedigrees and advertisements.

Eligibility and Application

- The Awards Chairperson does no tracking of animal performance and it is the responsibility of the applying owner to provide a complete application and all appropriate supporting documents - including copies of official title certificates - to the Chairperson. The owner also must track when their animal meets criteria for a specific award level.
- Applicant must be an owner of the dog/bitch receiving the award.
- Applicant must be an IHCUS member in good standing with the club.
- Eligibility for these awards is retroactive to the inception of the Club.
- Applicant must provide a completed application with appropriate supporting documentation (i.e. copies of certifications, AKC reports). Incomplete applications will not be considered until made complete.
- Application deadlines will coincide with The Third Eye deadlines. Applications received after the quarterly deadline will be held for the next period.
- You will be asked to provide a photo of your choice for The Third Eye publication, failure to provide will result in announcement of award without the photo.

Program Levels & Criteria

This program is open to any Ibizan Hound whose owner or co-owner is a current member in good standing with IHCUS at the time of application.

The Versatility Award is designed so that the average Ibizan Hound and owner, with some effort, can earn one. It asks for one title in three different fields and a total of three points for the first level.

These awards are designed to award the well-rounded Ibizan Hound and Owner.

When an animal fulfills the criteria for a specific versatility title level, the owner may submit their Versatility Program Application Form with the supporting documentation. The award will be listed in the next T.E. following the approval of application. *All certificates will be awarded as they are approved. Plaques may be awarded at the IHCUS National Specialty*

ACTUAL AWARD: The award will be a certificate suitable for framing signed by the president of the club and Awards committee representative to include the following information:

The name: Ibizan Hound Club of the United States Versatility Award

The name of the Award level (see below)

The registered name of the dog (with all titles, as the owner wishes it to appear on award)

The name of the owner(s) of record (at least ONE owner must be a current IHCUS member.

The date the Award is presented.

All awards will be listed on the IHCUS website and will include the Registered Name, Call Name, Owner(s), Breeder(s) and Award earned.

John also judged the conformation match, and awarded Wild Eve (owned and bred by Sarah Murphy) Best Puppy in Match. Winners Dog and Best in Match went to Fin (Am/Can DC IcyCold Infinity 2The3rd Power SC FCh LCM), owned by Robin Davis and Karen Catt. Winners Bitch was MeMe, and Reserve Winners Bitch was Dory. Reserve Winners dog went to the veteran, Wifi.

Saturday's trials yielded the same results, with Ensign continuing his winning streak by taking Best of Breed at the AKC and ASFA trials. The judges were John Arvin and Eddie Kominek for the ASFA trial, and Cindy Hamilton for the AKC trial. On Sunday, judges Don Ewing and Eddie Kominek again chose Ensign as their Best of Breed at the ASFA trial.

Not to be outdone by his brother, Best of Breed at the Monday ASFA trial went to Fin! It was apparent that Fin was done being the bridesmaid, and had to beat his brother at least once in the weekend.





The winner of the Dino Award, with 112 dogs defeated, went to Ensign. The weekend truly belonged to Ensign, and was without equal on the coursing field until the very end. Only nine Ibizans qualified for the Dino Award by running all six trials and participating in the fun match. Those hounds were:
