FARM DOG CERTIFICATION TEST

The basic test requirements are designed to demonstrate a dog's trainability, self-control, confidence and trust when working in partnership with their owner. The test is a non-competitive pass/fail evaluation designed to assess the overall conduct of a dog. The dog must demonstrate self-control when exposed to livestock and other unique sights, sounds and scents. The dog should exhibit confidence and a willingness to comply with instructions when confronted with a variety of situations within farm type surroundings

TEST ELEMENTS:

Test elements may be arranged in any order with the exception of the first and last element (#1 & #12)

- 1) GREET JUDGE – INITIAL DOG APPRAISAL
- 2) PERFORM A WALKING PATTERN AROUND FARM ENVIRONMENT / PASSIVE STRANGER
- 3) JUMP ON HAY/STRAW BALE
- 4) WALK BY FARM ANIMALS
- 5) WALK OVER OR THROUGH UNUSUAL SURFACES
- 6) SUPERVISED SEPARATION
- 7) PASS THROUGH A GATE
- 8) HANDLER FEEDS LIVESTOCK
- 9) REACTION TO ANOTHER DOG
- 10) REACTION TO NOISE DISTRACTION
- 11) DOG APPROACHES LIVESTOCK
- 12) PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

What is ACT?

The Agility Course Test (ACT) is an entry level agility event designed to introduce and welcome beginning dogs and their handlers to the AKC sport of agility. In addition to demonstrating their dog's entry level skills, handlers will learn some of the sport's basics like how to fill out and AKC entry form, check-in, taking their dogs in and out of the ring, and much more. There are two levels of the ACT events – ACT1 and ACT2.

Classes: ACT1 is open to all dogs that have not earned a title in any AKC agility class. The course will be between 10-12 obstacles, including an a-frame, table, jumps, and tunnels. Teams must complete the course in 60 seconds and with a minimum score of 85 to qualify. Two qualifying scores are required to earn the ACT1 title.

ACT2 is the second level of the ACT and is open to all dogs that have not earned a title in any AKC agility class except for an ACT1. The course will be between 11-13 obstacles, including an a-frame, teeter, dog walk, tire, table, jumps, spread jumps, weaves (6), and tunnels. Teams must complete the course in 70 seconds and with a minimum score of 85. Two qualifying scores are required to earn the ACT2 title.

Refusals and Run outs will not be judged. More than 3 attempts at the next correct obstacle will result in a Mandatory Elimination. The 4-paw rule is not in effect. Wrong courses, table faults, and dropped bars will judges ad in a regular agility class.

Entry forms must be filled out completely and signed to be accepted. No entries will be accepted by phone, email or fax.

 - a. 18" or greater = handicap is 1.0

 - c. Below 12" = handicap is 2.0
5. Points = MPH multiplied by the dog's handicap
6. Fast CAT suffix titles are earned at designated milestones:
 - a. BCAT = 150 points
 - b. DCAT = 500 points
 - c. FCAT = 1,000 points
 - d. FCAT# = every additional 500 points
7. Timing Devices: The time to complete the 100 yard dash is recorded to the nearest 1/100th of a second (e.g. 9.11). The Club uses break-the-beam equipment to obtain the time but may use stopwatches. If stopwatches are used, there shall be two timers positioned at the finish line. An individual at the start line shall signal with an arm drop the moment the nose of the dog crosses the start line. The timers shall start their stopwatches at the bottom of the arm drop. The timers shall stop their watches when the nose of the dog crosses the finish line. The times from the two stopwatches shall be averaged to determine the recorded time.
