What is ACT?

The Agility Course Test (ACT) is an entry level agility event designed to introduce and welcome beginning dogs and their handlers to the AKC sport of agility. In addition to demonstrating their dog's entry level skills, handlers will learn some of the sport's basics like how to fill out and AKC entry form, check-in, taking their dogs in and out of the ring, and much more. There are two levels of the ACT events – ACT1 and ACT2.

Classes: ACT1 is open to all dogs that have not earned a title in any AKC agility class. The course will between 10-12 obstacles, including an a-frame, table, jumps, and tunnels. Teams must complete the course in 60 seconds and with a minimum score of 85 to qualify. Two qualifying scores are required to earn the ACT1 title.

ACT2 is the second level of the ACT and is open to all dogs that have not earned a title in any AKC agility class except for an ACT1. The course will be between 11-13 obstacles, including an a-frame, teeter, dog walk, tire, table, jumps, spread jumps, weaves (6), and tunnels. Teams must complete the course in 70 seconds and with a minimum score of 85. Two qualifying scores are required to earn the ACT2 title.

Dogs eligible to enter must be 15 months or order to enter and must meet the requirements for a regular AKC agility trial (Chapter 1, Section 3). **Dogs are not required to be registered with the AKC to enter the ACT trial.** In order to acquire the title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered with the AKC. Dogs that are not registered with the AKC will have their performance recorded with the AKC under a temporary recording number. The temporary number will be emailed to the owner and must be used when entering subsequent ACT events and when the owner registers the dog.

Dogs can run the course at any jump height (4", 8", 12", 16", 20", or 24"). A jump height card is not required to enter an ACT test. Measuring will not be done at this event.

Open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Females in season may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event. (An event is defined by an event number.) Dogs requiring registry in Canine Partners must be spayed or neutered and are subject to a separate registration fee of \$35.00 to the AKC.

TESTS, TITLES&TIMING

HowDoesaFastCATWork?

- 1. Fast CAT is a timed straight race of 100 yards.
- 2. Dogs run singularly.
- 3. The dog's time to complete the 100 yd dash is converted into mph
- 4. A handicap system is applied to a dog's MPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:
 - a. 18" or greater = handicap is 1.0
 - b. 12" up to less than 18" = handicap is 1.5
 - c. Below 12" = handicap is 2.0
- 5. Points = MPH multiplied by the dog's handicap
- 6. Fast CAT suffix titles are earned at designated milestones:
 - a. BCAT = 150 points
 - b. DCAT = 500 points
 - c. FCAT = 1,000 points
 - d. FCAT# = every additional 500 points
- 7. Timing Devices: The time to complete the 100 yard dash is recorded to the nearest 1/100th of a second (e.g. 9.11). The Club uses break-the-beam equipment to obtain the time but may use stopwatches. If stopwatches are used, there shall be two timers positioned at the finish line. An individual at the start line shall signal with an arm drop the moment the nose of the dog crosses the start line. The timers shall start their stopwatches at the bottom of the arm drop. The timers shall stop their watches when the nose of the dog crosses the finish line. The times from the two stopwatches shall be averaged to determine the recorded time.
- 8. Area of the course is fenced.
