

Committee chair outreach: this is a typical request when a new BOD begins its term. Emails will be sent out to all committee heads checking in with new BOD and reaffirming positions.





Judges Critique - E. A. "Skip" Thielen

My congratulations to the Show Committee and staff for such a well-planned, well-run event. The Show Chair, Terrienne Basch, and her workers kept things running smoothly and on time. A special Thank You to my ring steward, Pam Mutchek, for running things ringside every judge knows that a competent ring steward is as good as gold. Considering the entry as a whole, I felt the variation of individual body styles I encountered, all within the Standard, supported many breed authorities' opinion that a measure of diversity is preferred over strict uniformity. A slightly different IH depending on environment and intended usage is not a bad thing. I found movement was mostly satisfactory, with a few exceptions ... however I had to repeatedly ask many of the exhibitors to slow down. When moved too fast, the Ibizan begins to over-extend in the front and lose the desired joint flexion in the process. Headpieces were not a problem (of course, there were one or two exceptions there, also). Head planes/proportions, ear sets, and the truncated cone called for in the standard were mostly in the ball park. I did notice that several muzzles were shorter than the 1:1 ratio called for with the back skull.

Also, two items worth mentioning: ear shape/size and bite (teeth). I'm told that the use of the term rhomboid in describing the shape of the ear was removed from the standard to avoid confusion (?), but it still remains important to many breeders. Several of the ears I saw were more triangular and shorter, in proportion to base width, than what's called for in the standard. Teeth: this is a tricky one. I saw several bites that were not only poor examples of a scissors, they were clearly overshot, and therefore faulted in the overall evaluation of the exhibit. The standard calls for a "scissors bite, strong and well set." There is no requirement for full and proper dentition (42 teeth/correct side occlusion). In my opinion, this is unfortunate for a sight hound expected to catch and hold its prey. The standard also specifies that the nose extends beyond the lower jaw. This might, unintentionally, cause breeders to overlook a progressively weaker/receding lower jaw that is so very important to the role of the breed. The [potential] weakening of a strong, lean, lower jaw can negatively influence the positioning of the lower teeth in the scissors bite, as well as adequate space for tooth placement along the jaw (side occlusion).

Having said all of the above, I was pleased to have such a nice entry from which to select my winners. The entry was 35 Ibizans, with 31 entries in competition that day. My AKC status is currently permit/provisional, plus I'm still learning the finer points of the breed, so an entry of this size allowed me to compare several variations of Ibizans to the standard. The primary task of the judge is to select the exhibit that most closely adheres to the standard. And since there are no perfect Ibizans, this means that most likely, the judge has to decide what positive aspects are worthy of recognition and what negative aspects have to be tolerated (the really bad negatives are called disqualifications!). Some aspects are clearly evident from ringside: profile, movement, rectangular outline, etc., while others are only evident to the judge through hands-on examination, especially in a long-coated exhibit. And all go into the judge forming an overall opinion of each exhibit.

The Ibizan I selected for Best of Breed was, in my opinion, the best overall package in the ring that day. Great proportions, moderation throughout, with good head piece/ear set. Good, flowing neck-to-topline, well-muscled loin descending to the properly low-set tail, and nicely matching front/rear angulation. I saw an effortless side gait, with good flexion on the extension, and near-perfect down & back movement showing the desired single-track foot placement. After judging, I was pleased to learn that the Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex winners were littermates.

Best of Winners had what I thought was the best front assembly I'd seen all day. Even the shoulder blade laybacks at the withers had the proper separation to allow the head/neck to dip down and scoop up prey at speed. A wonderful headpiece with great expression. A bit more depth of chest would give more room for heart/lungs, but my overall impression was, "This hound can run!"

My congratulations to all the winners. In both Winners Dog and Winners Bitch competition, no class winner looked out of place and each exhibit deserved my full attention and evaluation. The day was an enjoyable learning experience for me, and I sincerely hope I was able to create an enjoyable experience in the ring for each exhibitor.

Judges Critique - Alice Mirestes

Thank you for inviting me to judge the Sweepstakes at the Ohio Beezer Bash. It was a wonderful venue with a beautiful entry that gives me hope for our breed.

Overall the entry was quite pleasing moving and had beautiful type represented by all the variations of style we see in our breed. I saw a lot of dogs with good shoulders and correct outlines. We all need to keep an eye on depth of underjaw in our breeding programs as I saw a few with slightly overshot bites. I always wish puppies weren't first in the ring at 8am as they need some time to settle before they go in the ring.

Judges Critique - Continued

Puppy Dog 6-9 Months

1st Harehill's Monkey Wrench - Sound moving puppy with a nice head piece with a correct neck set and a solid front assembly. Ultimately my Best of Opposite in Sweeps and strong contender for Best In Sweeps. Topline was a little soft on this day which should come with maturity.

Puppy Dogs 9-12 Months

1st Kibby's American Pharoah of Sada N Treybeau - This puppy exuded correct breed type in all areas. He had a beautiful headpiece and an outstanding outline. Clean coming and going. He was somewhat restricted in his side gait.

2nd Red Stripe A Case For DaVinci - Nice young dog with lots of potential. He was a bit full of himself and did not show himself to his potential. A little on the large size, but had moments where you could see he has beautiful effortless side gait.

Junior Dogs 12-15 Months

1st Nahala's Winter Dragon - Clean down and back with nice side gait. Nice head piece. Would like to see a little more length of body.

2nd DaVinci Nahala Cubs Thrills and Chills - Beautiful breed type on this young dog from his correct head piece to his outline. He was full of himself and wanting to play a bit too much.

Puppy Bitches 6-9 Months

1st Harehill's Monkeying Around - This bitch has beautiful breed type from her beautiful head piece and correct outline. She displayed moments of correct floating side gait characteristic of the breed.

2nd Harehill's Sock Monkey - Another beautiful puppy bitch with beautiful breed type. Super strong front assembly with characteristic prominent prosternum. Clean coming and going with nice side gait. She was a little soft in the back which should improve with age.

Puppy Bitch 9-12 Months

1st Kibby N Treybeau's Light My Fire - This puppy exuded correct breed type in all areas. She had a beautiful headpiece and an outstanding outline. Clean coming and going. She was somewhat restricted in her side gait. Really lovely bitch.

Junior Bitches 12-15 Months

1st Nahala's Arctic Sky Dance - Oh so feminine and elegant! This bitch possessed a correct outline with fluid, floating movement and ring presence. Ultimately my Best In Sweeps. I would like to see a bit more substance in bone and in her muzzle.

Junior Bitches 15-18 Months

1st Honeymoon's Guns N Roses Compelling Gypsy - A strong, honest wire bitch with clean movement coming and going. Beautiful headpiece and neck into shoulders. A little high in the rear and restricted on the side at this time.

First I want to take a moment to thank the exhibitors who participated in veterans. I always get a little teary with the old dogs. Also I feel strongly about making sure the old dogs get all the applause during this event. Remember while it isn't your dog in the ring at that time it is special to the handler and the dog in the ring.

Veteran Dog 7-10 Years

1st Ch L-Wynd's Talent Compels A Soul SC - Sweet guy with ring presence and clean movement. He seemed to enjoy being in the ring today.

Veteran Bitch 10 Years and Over

1st DC GCh Davinci's White Witch At Heron And Hound SC LCX HOF VC - Beautiful wire bitch! At over 10 years of age in great condition and exhibited effortless side gait. Coat has correct texture. She has a lovely headpiece and correct outline. Ultimately my Best In Sweeps. Even at her age she could be a contender in any ring.
