

Board Meeting Minutes

October 10, 2019

Call to Order: 7:12 CST

Present: Heidi Clevenstine, Meg Smith, Alex Mitchell-Lynch, John Schnieder, Kurt Anderson, Terrienne Basch

Absent: Meegan Pierotti-Tietji

President's Report: None

Approval of September Board Minutes: Heidi moved, Terrienne 2nd-all in favor, motion passed

Correspondence:

1. Letter from Purina regarding property damage done to roads at National Specialty. It was noted that the member had been contacted and was handling directly with Purina. Terrienne suggested that the club draft a letter to Purina to let them know that it was not appreciated that construction was being done while our National was being held and that better direction and marking of alternate routes would have been appreciated. Meg to contact Purina before National next year to make sure that there will be no construction or obstacles again.

2. Request from Zeke Dickson for help on filming an Ibizan Hound documentary for YouTube. Meegan will reach out to California members to see if they would be interested in helping.

Meegan joined the call

3. Perpetual Trophy Discussion.... according to AKC, the perpetual trophies can be awarded-just not during the actual National Specialty. They need to be displayed on a separate table and awarded at the Top 20. Meg stated that the names had not been updated on the plaques. Meg to reach out to the previous winners and ask them to pay to have their names added (as this is how it is supposed to be done).

4. National Trophy Proposal-member Leah Hartlep proposed that the previous years' winners sponsor the trophy for the following year. For example: Meegan to sponsor Best of Breed because Church won in 2019. Leah agreed to send a letter to previous years' winners in her proposal and would be responsible for spearheading the donations. Meg moved, Meegan 2nd, all approved, motion passed to allow this proposal to move forward. Meg to reach out to Leah to inform her and ask her to draft the letter and send back to the board for approval.

5. Request to add 2 more IHCUS sponsored agility trials in 2020. They will be held in June and August. Easy money for the club-Terrienne and Chris would handle everything regarding these additional trials.

Meegan moved, Kurt 2nd, all in favor, motion approved to add the 2 extra trials.

6. Show Secretary (Superintendent) Proposal for 2020 National Specialty. Run4FunTN, Chris Allen, proposed to be the Super for the National at around half of the cost of Foy Trent. Discussion ensued. Heidi moved, John 2nd to approve the change of Super to Run4FunTN, Chris Allen, for the 2020 National, all in favor, motion passed.

7. 2021 and 2022 Judges Selection for National Specialty. Chris Allen sent a list of judges approved to judge Ibizans. Meg to post list to the Third Eye forum to be added to the upcoming issue. There will also need to be an insert put with the Third Eye for membership voting purposes. Meegan moved, Heidi 2nd, all in favor, motion passed to insert the judge's selection into the upcoming issue of the Third Eye.

8. Chris Allen asked the Board via proposal to let her order 150 more New Title Medallions for agility. Terrienne moved, John 2nd, all approved, motion passes.

9. Marilyn Brown sent a letter to the Board regarding a Perpetual Trophy that she had donated to the club in Sue Fagan's honor back in 2013. She

stated that the trophy was brought to the National by Katie Campbell but had somehow ended up in someone's personal collection and was offered for sale on a social media site. Marilyn asked the board to attempt to find the trophy and put it back in rotation or send back to her. Heidi agreed to check with Katie Campbell and see if she has any ideas where the trophy went after she brought to the National. Also, an apology letter will be sent to Marilyn.

10. Futurity Proposal was presented. Alex would like for one of the proposers to be in on a call to explain further. Since the deadline for litters would be November 1, 2019, it was decided to compile a list of questions to be sent to the proposers by the end of Friday, October 11, 2019. Once the answers are received, Meg will post to the forum. This subject was tabled for clarity.

New checks have been ordered and received. Kurt is currently doing an audit on the account to get expenses and income recorded properly. Meg asked Kurt if he could reimburse Marisa and Sabrina as well as send the deposit for the Beezer Bash rosettes. He stated that he would take care of all of those on Friday, October 11, 2019.

New Title Medallions were proposed to offer to all titled Ibizan Hounds whether they belong to a member or not. An application and fee will need to be submitted and then Terrienne will send out the award. Terrienne designed a Medallion with the IHCUS Logo on the front and the Beezer Bash Logo on the back. Heidi moved, Meg 2nd, all in favor for Terrienne to purchase 300 medallions at the cost of

\$2.23 each.

President's Report – Alex Mitchell-Lynch thanked the Board for being patient as she maneuvered her new position.
Oct. Board Minutes were approved with having Board members last names added and spelling errors corrected. With that proviso, Meg Smith moved to accept the minutes as revised, John Snyder seconded it. The motion passed unanimously.

Correspondence – a letter from Leah

Hartlep was read suggesting a program where trophy donations could maybe be paid forward. After much discussion, the Board decided further research was warranted for any decision could be made and referred the suggestion to the National Specialty Committee.

Regarding judge selection for the

all breed shows the weekend of the 2020 National Specialty, Chris Allen moved to post on the IHCUS Members Only page asking members for suggestions that can be passed on to Three Rivers ASAP. It was suggested this be done giving a deadline of 11/23 in order to give Three Rivers time to secure their panel. John Snyder seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Heidi Clevestine gave an update on a situation where Marilyn Brown had inquired about a piece of artwork by Sue Fegan that Marilyn had sent to the National Specialty some years ago to donate in Sue's memory. She did not know where the piece had ended up and was concerned. After a little inquiry, the piece was located with Nan Kilgore Little. We are now working out what next to do with the piece, both for preservation and possible reproduction.

The proposed new Futurity had been submitted to the membership. The funds for this program will be labeled as a separate account with the Treasurer.

There was an update on the Outreach Committee – Jennifer Hathcoat has agreed to accept the Chair of this committee following Carol Kaufmann stepping down.

Chris Allen requested permission to pay all of the AKC application fees for the 2020 IHCUS events. The Board approved the use of the club credit card for this purpose.

Chris Allen Moved that IHCUS offer medallions to be offered to the winners at the AKC Invitational in Orlando. Heidi Clevestine seconded.

The motion passed unanimously.

Chris Allen informed the Board she has submitted the P&L report from the agility trials held in Ohio 11/9/19-11/10/19 to the Treasurer. The club netted 1,710.91 from the event.

A list of volunteers for IHCUS Committee Chairs and committee members will be submitted to the Board. Chris Allen moved that the ASFA and AKC Lure Coursing committees be combined into one committee – the Coursing Committee. John Snyder seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Chris Allen was also approved to order more qualifying ribbons for the upcoming agility trials in 2020.

Meegan Pierotti-Tietje moved for adjournment, John Snyder seconded and the meeting was adjourned at 10:04pm.





The changes to the IHCUS Awards Program were made because IHCUS is an AKC club and the board has decided that we would only recognize AKC titles except for the following:

ASFA: ASFA lure coursing existed before AKC lure coursing and many Ibizan Hounds take part in this venue.

LGRA: Straight Racing is not offered by AKC.

NOTRA: Oval Racing is not offered by AKC.

NOFCA: Open field coursing is not offered by AKC.

All awards: *Hall of Fame, First Titled Ibizan, Register of Merit, Producer of Merit, and all levels of Versatility* may be applied for by **Members & Non-Members of IHCUS in good standing with the AKC.**

Fees are now charged for all award applications (see table below). Certificates and medallions are included in the application fee. Previous Award recipients can purchase medallions & additional medallions can be purchased at a reduced cost. Plaques may also be purchased for an additional cost.


