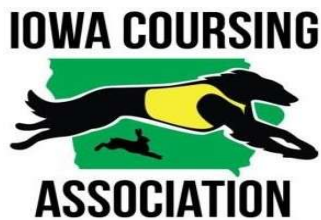

ENTRY FEES

Pre-entry: \$22 first hound entry; \$17 each additional entry (same owner)

Gate entry: \$27 per hound.

Junior Handler*: \$17 per hound (pre-entry or gate entry)

** A Junior is defined as anyone younger than 18 years of age. The Junior must handle/release the hound to qualify for the reduced entry fee. Juniors should apply for and receive an AKC Junior Handler Number prior to trial day. Junior Handler Certification forms will be available from the Trial Secretary. If the hound is entered under this provision but the Junior does not handle/release it, the owner must pay the regular entry fee as published in the premium.*

INSPECTION: 7:30AM – 8:15AM

** Early acceptance of hounds for members of the field committee may begin one-half hour prior to published trial hours.*

Each entry will be inspected for breed disqualifications, lameness, fitness to compete, and females in season. If in the opinion of the inspection committee, any entry found to be lame, unfit to safely compete, have breed disqualifications, or a female in season, that hound shall not be allowed to run and entry fees shall be refunded; bitches in season shall be removed from the trial site.

ROLL CALL: 8:15AM

Hounds not present at roll call will be scratched after 5-minute grace period.

ELIGIBILITY

All hounds one year of age or older from the following breeds are eligible to participate in Lure Coursing Events. Eligible hounds must be either individually registered with AKC, recorded with the Foundation Stock Service, (FSS), individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, or that have been granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL/ILP).

AKC Recognized Breeds: Afghan Hound, Azawakh, Basenji, Borzoi, Cirneco Dell Etna, Greyhound, Ibizan Hound, Irish Wolfhound, Italian Greyhound, Pharaoh Hound, Portuguese Podengo Pequeno, Rhodesian Ridgeback, Saluki, Scottish Deerhound, Sloughi, Whippet

Note: Portuguese Podengo Pequeno are not eligible to compete for Best in Field.

Miscellaneous Group*: Norrbottenspets, Peruvian Inca Orchid, Portuguese Podengos (Medio & Grande)

Foundation Stock Service Breed*: Thai Ridgeback

*May compete for suffix titles only and are not eligible to compete for Best in Field

• A hound with an AKC Limited Registration or Conditional Registration is eligible to participate.

- Spayed and neutered hounds are eligible to participate.
- **Hounds with breed disqualifications, as listed in the AKC Breed Standard, are ineligible to enter lure coursing trials and tests.**
- Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are eligible to participate provided they have no breed disqualifications as listed in the AKC Breed Standard.
- Bitches in season are not eligible to participate.

Qualified Courser (QC) Certificate: A hound at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed—or another breed with a similar running style—(Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The qualifying hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound.

STAKES OFFERED (No hound may enter more than one stake)

Junior Courser (JC) Test: A hound at least 12 months of age running alone shall receive one qualification from a judge, and a second qualification from a different judge at a separate event, stating that the hound completed the course with enthusiasm and without interruption. After earning a JC title, a hound may continue to enter JC tests for the pleasure of the dog and owner.

Open Stake: Open to all hounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate or ASFA Certification Course certificate. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a Field Championship title from the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). ASFA or CKC Field Champions must submit a copy of their title certificate to the host club when they enter their first AKC Open Stake. This copy must be included when the results of the trial are sent to the AKC. Championship points earned from the Open Stake will only count toward a Field Champion title. Hounds that have earned an AKC Field Championship title of record are not eligible to enter the Open Stake

Specials Stake: Open to all hounds that have earned their AKC Field Championship titles. Championship points earned from the Specials Stake will count toward Lure Courser Excellent titles. Qualifying scores earned from the Specials Stake will count toward a Senior Courser or Master Courser title.

Veteran Stake: Open to all hounds which are eligible to enter Open or Special stakes and meet the age requirement for a veteran as established by the breed's parent club – 6 years of age; except Irish Wolfhounds = 5 years, Whippets = 7 years, Rhodesian Ridgebacks = 7 years, Ibizan Hounds = 7 years, Salukis = 7 years, and Afghan Hounds = 7 years. Championship points will be awarded. Points won from the Veteran Stake may count toward either a Field Championship title or Lure Courser Excellent title.

*If there is a tie for first place in a stake and there are dogs from only two stakes that are going to run off for Best of Breed, these three dogs shall be run together to determine the stake winner and Best of Breed. *

Singles Stake: No points or passes counting toward AKC titles shall be awarded. All regulations pertaining to regular stakes shall apply unless modified by the regulations specific to this stake. Singles Stakes shall be run as follows:

- (a) Open to all sighthound breeds approved to participate in AKC Lure Coursing trials.
- (b) **Hounds with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter.**
- (c) Hounds entered in the Singles Stake shall not be allowed to enter the regular

- stakes (open, specials or veteran) at the same event.
- (d) Order of running shall be determined by random draw.
 - (e) Each hound shall run the course alone.
 - (f) Judges shall score a dog's performance the same as a regular stake.
 - (g) Single Stake entries from all breeds shall be combined to determine placements.
 - (h) Placements shall be awarded based on the combined preliminary and final course scores. The winner of the stake shall not be eligible to compete in Best of Breed and/or Best in Field courses.
 - (i) The host club shall award ribbons to placing hounds. Ribbon colors applicable to regular stakes shall apply. No Best of Breed ribbon will be awarded.

HOW TO ENTER

- Pre-entry:
 1. Mail completed entry form and payment to Trial Secretary
 2. Enter and pay online: <https://form.jotform.com/260497588950171>
- Gate entry: present entry form and payment to the Trial Secretary before close of entries.

- Since entries are limited, pre-entries will be acknowledged by e-mail provided a legible e-mail address is included on the entry form.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Separate entry forms and entry fees are required for each hound for each event entered.
2. A fee of \$40.00 will be assessed for any returned checks.
3. Incomplete, unsigned, conditional, or unpaid entries will not be accepted.
4. Gate entries will be accepted if the entry limit listed on the front of this premium is not reached with pre-entries.
5. The Club and/or Trial Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry form.
6. Hounds must be ready for judging. Judges need not wait for hounds that hold up the test.
7. At the discretion of the Trial Chairman, there may be a \$5.00 fine assessed for any loose hound on the field not taking part in the course in progress.
8. Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds by the Field Committee. Children must be under the control of their parents or guardian at all times.
9. Only the lure operator, huntmaster, judges and handlers of the course in progress will be permitted near the lure operating equipment.

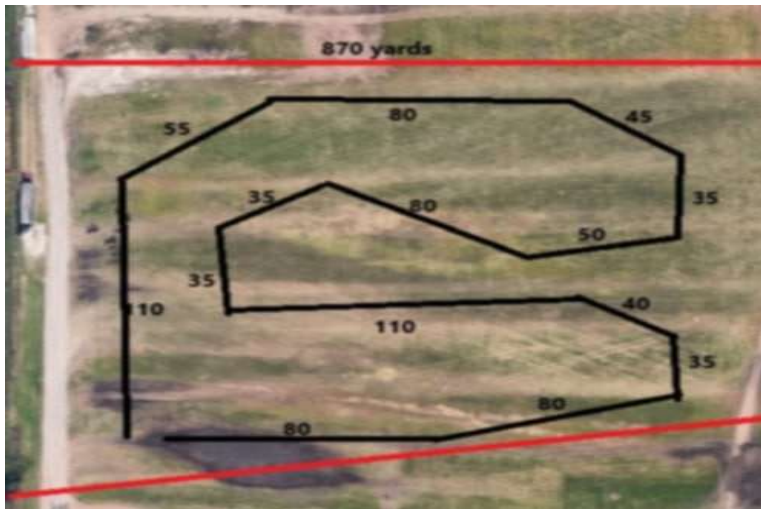
TIPS FOR HANDLERS

1. Handlers should wear comfortable, sturdy shoes (no sandals or flip flops) and be physically able to hold and release their dogs, as well as catch them.
2. Handlers may carry toys, whistles or small treats to reward and assist with retrieving their hound at the completion of their run. Treats may not be excessive to the point of distracting other hounds.
3. Handlers will provide each hound with a simplified lead which will give almost instantaneous freedom to the hound when released only upon a verbal signal ("Tally-Ho!") from the Huntmaster. Recommended slip leads are those consisting of a leather or webbing strap with a wide collar and double or single rings.
4. No collar or paraphernalia shall be on the hound during the running of the course except the blanket. Protective coverings in colors including yellow, pink and blue are acceptable.
5. The Huntmaster will instruct the handler to "Retrieve your hound" upon completion of the run. The handler is expected to promptly secure the hound and leave the field with the hound on leash.
6. Handlers are advised to warm up their hound prior to their run and walk them for 10 minutes afterwards.
7. Coursing is a physically demanding sport and can tax a hound's physical strength. Hounds that are old, have breathing or heart problems, are overweight, or are out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. Consult your veterinarian if you have any concerns.
8. Muzzles are not required but are permitted at the handler's discretion. Muzzles must not have sharp, hard edges and must allow the hound to breathe.
9. Special Training devices that are used to control and train dogs, including but not limited to, collars with prongs, electronic training devices may not be used on dogs at AKC events. Head halters, such as the Gentle Leader or Halti, may be used on the grounds but must not be worn while running the course.

COURSE PLANS

- The lure will consist of highly visible plastic strips.
- Course will be reversed for finals.
- Gas or battery powered continuous loop equipment will be used, including back up equipment.
- The field committee reserves the right to alter the course depending on the field and other conditions.

From Motel 6: on Hwy 63 N: Take 63 N 5.6 miles to Cedar-Wapsi Rd turn left. Take Cedar-Wapsi Rd 6 miles to Waverly Rd turn left. Antique Acres is 0.4 miles on the left.

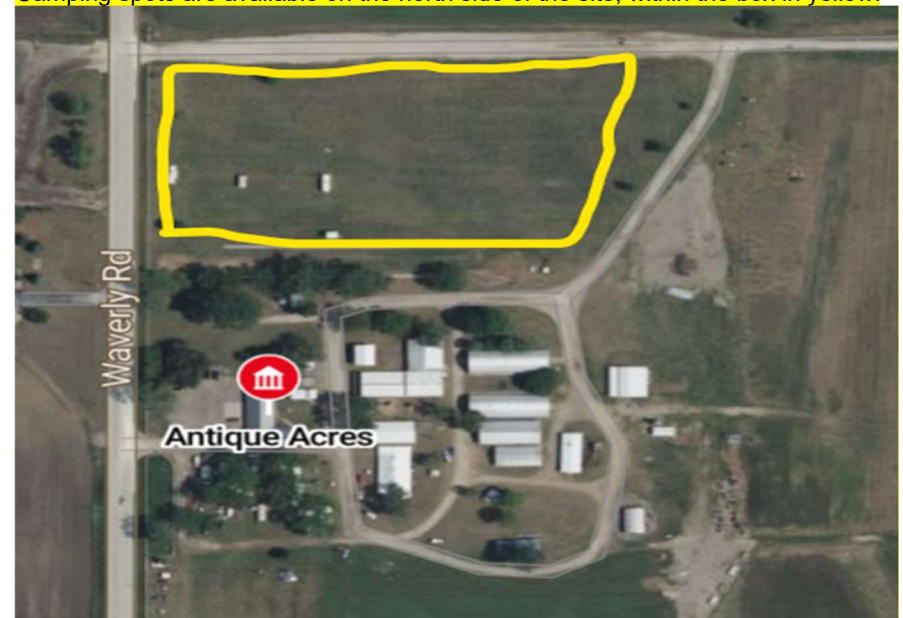
FACILITIES
